

Goodison Park GROUND DETAIL



Goodison Park has been the home of Everton F.C. since 1892. For many years it has been one of the finest grounds in the Football League, with a superb playing surface, excellent facilities for players, officials and spectators and a higher than average percentage of seated accommodation.

Record Attendance

The record attendance was a Liverpool 'Derby' game on September 18th, 1948, when 78,299 people packed the ground.

Ground Capacity

On September 29th 1977 the capacity was officially fixed at 52,810, including 23,000 seats. Alterations have now increased the overall capacity to 53,419.
